

## **Green Pass**

With the new Covid decree, the Government has established the latest rules regarding the green pass, vaccination obligation and restrictions.

### **GREEN PASS**

From 1 April, no passes will be needed for local transport, bars, open-air restaurants and hotels. It will no longer be required even to enter public offices, shops, banks or post offices. While the basic one will be enough for stadiums, concerts and long-distance vehicles.

Instead, the super green pass remains for indoor restaurants, bars, swimming pools and gyms, conferences and congresses, as well as for game rooms, ballrooms, discos and all indoor events. From May 1st, green certification will no longer be necessary even indoors, including work.

### **QUARANTINE**

From 1 April no more quarantine in case of contacts with a positive (even if not vaccinated), isolation remains only for the infected.

### **MASKS**

For the month of April we will continue to wear masks in all indoor places with the obligation of FFP2 for means of transport and for events.

From 1 May we will be able to eliminate them even indoors.

The basic green pass is obtained with:

- • vaccination, a new certification is issued for each vaccine dose: first dose, second dose or completion of primary vaccination cycle, booster;
- • Negative on a molecular test within the past 72 hours or a rapid antigen test within the preceding 48 hours;
- • recovered from COVID-19 for no more than six months.

The reinforced green pass (super green pass) is obtained with:

- • vaccination
- • recovered from COVID-19 for no more than six months.
